

Course Scope and Objectives

The Dehydration Experts course provides specialized training in the design, operation and troubleshooting of dehydration and refrigeration processes. The course scope and objectives include:

- Reviewing the science behind the formation of hydrates, dehydration and refrigeration systems and their application in gas processing;
- Providing an overview of current technologies for hydrate control, dehydration, hydrocarbon recovery and hydrocarbon dew point control;
- Providing practical process knowledge to facilitate system performance and optimization; and
- Equipping participants to recognize and troubleshoot performance problems.

The course provides a comprehensive overview of the need for, and application of dehydration and refrigeration technologies in gas processing. It also presents case studies to expose participants to a range of real-life operational problems. Each case is discussed in detail and solutions are provided. The course presents theoretical principles of dehydration and refrigeration but primarily focuses on practical aspects of system design and operation.

The course will be of value to anyone interested in obtaining information on the current status of dehydration and refrigeration in gas processing. In particular, scientists, engineers and operators involved in the design and operation of dehydration systems will obtain practical information to help improve system performance.

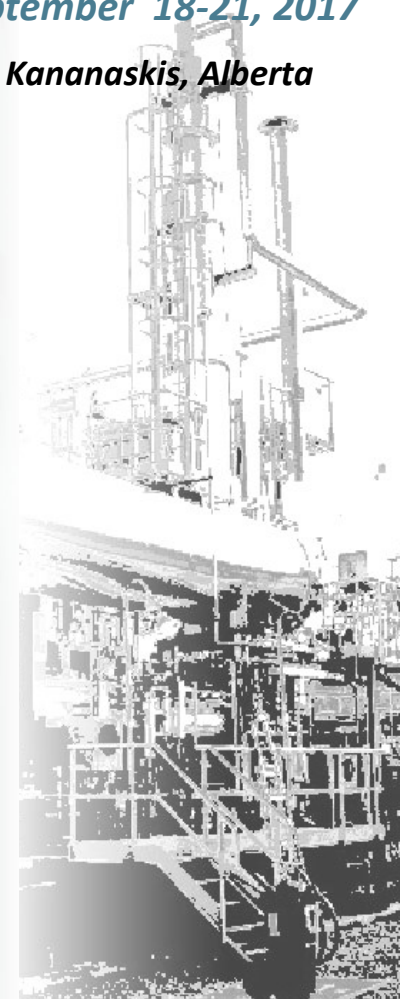
